**SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM:** The Rincon Tribal Government will be sponsoring the summer Youth Employment Program (Y.E.P.) again this summer. The program is designed to provide Rincon Tribal Member and Descendant youth between the ages of 16-20 valuable work experience by working for the various Tribal Government Departments for a ten (10) week period over the summer. The program provides employment opportunities for 10 positions. The experience will provide each applicant a real life experience in the hiring process. Potential YEP staffers will need to complete an application which can be obtained at the Human Resources Department at the Butler Building. Applicants will then be interviewed by a panel of Tribal Government Management staff and the top ten candidates will be selected. The application period will be open May 1<sup>st</sup> - May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Interviews will be held May 26-28 with selections and notifications June 1-3. The program will start on Monday, June 15<sup>th</sup> and end on Friday, August 21<sup>st</sup>. The work week will comprise 40 hours with most work schedules running 8:00 am - 4:30 pm Monday through Friday. The pay rate is \$10.50 per hour.
